Principal's Report -

- Third quarter is a heavy academic period.
- The leadership team has looked at school data and is working on goals for next year.
- Google is discontinuing old Chromebooks in the fall of 2021. The district will replace the ones originally purchased, but the school will have to replace the chromebooks they purchased - Churchill will use surplus from Land trust tax and TSSP funding to purchase four Chromebook carts (projected 7 year lifespan). Any surplus funds will be used to fund instruction time for teachers.
- Parent Teacher conferences are coming up next week.
- CCA classes are moving up to 8th grade - so they will not be offered next year. Offering STEM classes instead to fill the gaps.
